FAMILY REUNIFICATION Under Refugee Act, 2024

UNDER REFUGEE ACT, 2024, RECOGNISED REFUGEES CAN APPLY TO BRING THEIR FAMILY TO LIVE WITH THEM IN THE DRC.

- The application would be reviewed by the National Refugee Eligibility Subcommittee.
- The Subcommittee would then check your relationship with the family member before making its decision.
- Family members and dependents could be granted permission to enter and stay legally in the DRC.
- Unaccompanied children entering the DRC would be assessed and protected under child protection laws.
- A "child" means anyone under 18 years old.
- The Minister could cancel permission only for national security or public interest reasons.

PRINCIPLE OF FAMILY UNITY

This clause is based on the idea that families should stay together. All
applications for reunion would be handled with this principle in mind.
